

Scanning high volumes of large format documents can reduce floor and storage space in your warehouse and increase your workflow and productivity. For service bureaus, document preservation projects are a lucrative business opportunity.

When you are using an Image Access scanner for volume scanning jobs of large format documents, the most time consuming tasks are usually not the scans themselves, but the time it takes the operator to feed the document into the scanner and change the source document after each scan.

To optimize this throughput bottleneck, Image Access offers Document Return Guides for the WideTEK 36C, designed to

make volume scanning more comfortable for the operator and speed of document changing after each scan.

Attached to the back wall of the scanner, the two magnetic document return guides send the scanned document back over the top of the scanner to make feeding the next document a more ergonomic process for the operator. The guides are adjustable for optimal placement based on the width of the batch of documents being scanned, further increasing production speed.
